

## **2024 Presidents' Cup Challenge**

### **What is the Presidents' Cup Challenge?**

Forty teams from four clubs – Almonte, Arnprior, Huntley and Richmond – compete in seven divisions over a weekend in March for bragging rights and a trophy. Initiated by the Huntley Curling Club in 2019, this is the third year for this prestigious bonspiel.

### **What are the Presidents' Cup Challenge Divisions?**

Senior Mixed 50+ - 1 team  
Senior Men 50+ - 1 team  
Senior Women 50+ - 1 Team  
Open Mixed 19+ - 1 team  
Open Men 19+ - 2 teams  
Open Women 19+ - 2 teams  
Colts (U6) 19+ - 2 teams

### **How can I get on a Presidents' Cup Challenge team?**

Each club will identify their team(s) for each division.

- a) Each curler may only play for their own club.
- b) Each curler may only play for one team and cannot spare on another team.
- c) Spares are allowed but can spare only for one team, and must meet the age and gender criteria for the curler they are replacing.
- d) Minimum age for Senior teams is 50 years as of 8 March 2024
- e) Minimum age for Open and U6 teams is 19 years as of 8 March 2024
- f) Curlers in the U6 Division must have less than 6 years curling experience in a regular club league. Curlers who are presently in their 6<sup>th</sup> year of curling are still eligible for this division.
- g) U6 teams may be composed of any combination of male and female curlers.
- h) A Mixed team format is either MWMW or WMWM.
- i) A team may play with 3 players. In the event that a Mixed team is playing with three players, the team format is either MWM or WMW.

### **How much does it cost to play in the Presidents' Cup Challenge?**

Each team will pay \$260 to enter.
